NOTICE TO DEPOTS: LARGE QUANTITY OF UNLABELLED MILK JUGS IN CALGARY

Attention depot operators and staff,

Today, February 5, 2016, the BCMB was notified of a male customer driving a **grey odyssey van with an Alberta license plate (BNZ 8493)**. The individual had a large number of “Menchie” milk jugs, with no labels or barcode. The individual refused to fill out and sign the CVR form.

Please be aware that these containers could be brought into your Depot in the near future (especially if you are in close proximity/ Calgary area). If you suspect that these containers have arrived at your Depot, have the individual fill out the Container Validation Request (CVR) form (attached) and **do not pay for these containers**. Please quarantine the containers at your Depot – do not provide a refund to the customer and do not ship the containers to ABCRC until advised by the BCMB. Be sure to document how many bags/containers were left and provide the customer with the BCMB phone number so they know who to contact should they have questions.

If the customer remains unwilling to fill out the form and wishes to leave with the product they may do so but please make note of the encounter and notify the BCMB.
