NOTICE TO ALL DEPOTS: BLANK ALUMINUM CANS IN CALGARY

Attention depot operators and staff,

The BCMB was notified by a Calgary Depot of two Caucasian male customers driving a **white Chevy Astro Van** (no plate number obtained), attempting to return a large quantity of blank (unlabelled) Aluminum cans. The cans are in two large industrial garbage bags (one white bag and one black bag). The individual refused to fill out and sign the Container Validation Request (CVR) form and left the Depot with the product when asked to fill one out.

Please be aware that these containers could be brought into your Depot in the near future (especially if you are in close proximity/Calgary area). If you suspect that these containers have arrived at your Depot, have the individual fill out the CVR form (attached) and **do not pay for these containers.** Please quarantine the containers at your Depot – do not provide a refund to the customer and do not ship the containers to ABCRC until advised by the BCMB. Be sure to document how many bags were left and provide the customer with the BCMB phone number so he knows who to contact regarding these containers.

If the customer remains unwilling to fill out the form and wishes to leave with the product they may do so but please make note of the encounter and notify the BCMB.
