NOTICE TO ALL DEPOTS: SUSPECTED OUT-OF-PROVINCE CONTAINERS IN LETHBRIDGE

Attention Depot operators and staff,

The BCMB was notified by a Lethbridge Depot of two male customers attempting to return a large quantity of beverage containers that are **suspected to have been brought in from out-of-province**. The individuals are driving a **large white 3-tonne truck with Montana plates 21-1069A** and had **10-15 large garbage bags** full of containers. The individuals are said to be from a Hutterite colony across the border. The individuals refused to fill out and sign the Container Validation Request (CVR) form and left the depot with the product.

Please be aware that these containers could be brought into your Depot in the near future (especially if you are in close proximity/Lethbridge area). If you suspect that these containers have arrived at your Depot, have the individual fill out the CVR form (attached) and **do not pay for these containers**. Please quarantine the containers at your Depot – do not provide a refund to the customer and do not ship the containers to ABCRC until advised by the BCMB. Be sure to document how many bags were left and provide the customer with the BCMB phone number so he knows who to contact regarding these containers.

If the customer remains unwilling to fill out the form and wishes to leave with the product they may do so but please make note of the encounter and notify the BCMB.
