NOTICE TO ALL DEPOTS: SUSPECTED OUT-OF-PROVINCE CONTAINERS IN MEDICINE HAT

Attention Depot operators and staff,

The BCMB was notified by a Medicine Hat Depot of a male customer attempting to return **American** beverage containers. The individual was driving a **white Ford F150 with a veteran plate** and had a **large cardboard box and garbage bag** full of aluminum containers. The individual was aggressive and refused to fill out and sign the Container Validation Request (CVR) form. He left the depot with the product.

Please be aware that these containers could be brought into your Depot in the near future (especially if you are in close proximity/Medicine Hat area). If you suspect that these containers have arrived at your Depot, have the individual fill out the CVR form (attached) and **do not pay for these containers**. Please quarantine the containers at your Depot – do not provide a refund to the customer and do not ship the containers to ABCRC until advised by the BCMB. Be sure to document how many bags were left and provide the customer with the BCMB phone number so he knows who to contact regarding these containers.

If the customer remains unwilling to fill out the form and wishes to leave with the product they may do so but please make note of the encounter and notify the BCMB.
