**NOTICE TO ALL DEPOTS: SUSPECTED OUT-OF-PROVINCE CONTAINERS, SOUTH OF CALGARY**

Attention Depot operators and staff,

The BCMB was notified by a Southern Depot of a male customer attempting to return a large quantity of beverage containers that are **suspected to have been brought in from out-of-province**. The individual was driving a **grey multi-passenger van with striping on the side** and had **numerous bags of crushed American aluminum (Busch) cans, and some glass (Budweiser) bottles**. The individual did not fill out or sign the Container Validation Request (CVR) form and left the depot with the product.

Please be aware that these containers could be brought into your Depot in the near future (especially if you are in close proximity/South of Calgary area). If you suspect that these containers have arrived at your Depot, have the individual fill out the CVR form (attached) and **do not pay for these containers**. Please quarantine the containers at your Depot – do not provide a refund to the customer and do not ship the containers to ABCRC until advised by the BCMB. Be sure to document how many bags were left and provide the customer with the BCMB phone number so he knows who to contact regarding these containers.

If the customer remains unwilling to fill out the form and wishes to leave with the product they may do so but please make note of the encounter and notify the BCMB.
