
BCMB Service Standards


Why don't you return containers to a depot, or why not more often?






Q13A. If a service was offered where you could drop off your containers without waiting in line and collect your money later, would you use this service?

Q13B. If yes, what would your preferred form of payment be?








Depot By-law

Unless otherwise directed by the Board:

- "the number of Depots allowed in a Metro Area shall be calculated by dividing the population of that Metro Area by 40,000.
- "no new Permit may be issued in a Metro or Urban Area for a Depot that will be located within a 3-kilometre radius of an existing and operating Depot.








Calgary 2018
