RE: Attempted Return of Unfilled HDPE Containers

Attention Depot Operators and Staff,

The Beverage Container Management Board ("BCMB") has been informed that on July 25, 2022, **two males driving a U-Haul truck with unit number DC 1162** attempted to return a **large quantity of HDPE milk containers** to Roper Bottle Depot in Edmonton. The containers all appeared to be unfilled and unlabeled. The customers refused to leave any containers at the depot and did not fill out the CVR form in its entirety.

This notice is to make depots aware of this occurrence in the event that this customer attempts to return these containers to another depot, particularly in the Edmonton area. Should these men visit your depot with these containers, please follow the CVR process. Please do not provide a refund for these containers, however they may be accepted as non-deposit bearing material to be recycled appropriately.
