**RE:** Alcohol Container Registrations – New Process, Fall 2023

As you are aware, the BCMB is undertaking a significant project to update the beverage container registration system. A key part of that project will include the transition of alcohol container registrations from Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis (AGLC) to the BCMB. The transition is planned for the fall of 2023.

Liquor agencies currently register products with AGLC on behalf of the alcohol manufacturers/product owners that they represent in Alberta, and AGLC then registers the containers in the BCMB registration system. The change means liquor agencies will be required to register alcohol containers **directly** with the BCMB through the new registration portal.

Having **all** container registrations completed in the new system ensures **all** beverage manufacturers (including alcohol, non-alcohol and cannabis) follow the same process for registration.

## How does the Change Impact You?

Other than transitioning to the new registration portal, the change in process for liquor agencies has no direct impact on non-alcohol manufacturers and other BCMB/industry stakeholders.
